
A MESSAGE FROM THE AUTHOR

Can a public family have private secrets? Because the Comptons' worst secrets are coming back to haunt them, and Claire Hunter is the only one who can unravel decades of lies.


But Claire has more than a few secrets of her own, and she will go to the grave to make sure no one finds out the truth.

- 6) The setting of this novel sets the stage and the mood for the events that follow. Have you ever been to a location where you could feel the history of the place just by walking its corridors?
- 7) One of the main themes of *Her Dark Lies* is the idea that everyone lies to protect something or someone. Is it ever okay to keep the truth hidden from your spouse? If so, why?
- 8) Can you ever completely trust another person?
- 9) What are your thoughts on Claire's decision at the end of the novel. Why do you think she makes the choice she does and is it justifiable?
- 10) What's the biggest lie you've ever told?
